

“Preston’s Pride: The People’s Plane” Documentary Premiere May 10, 2019

Deemed as one of the most significant aircraft in existence today, 'Preston's Pride' is the last surviving B-17 which took part in the "Operation Crossroads" atomic bomb testing.
